CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1.** The tournament is sanctioned by TENNIS SCOTLAND and will be run in strict accordance with the current rules of Tennis Scotland, the ITF Rules of Tennis, the Rules of the LTA and the LTA Tournament Regulations, including the LTA Code of Conduct (as each may be amended from time to time). I acknowledge and agree that I am subject to the Rules and Regulations of the LTA (including, without limitation, the LTA's Tournament Regulations, Anti-Doping Programme, Disciplinary and Dispute Resolution Procedures and the Regulations Concerning Match Fixing, Financial Speculation and Betting) and hereby fully and unconditionally submit to the jurisdiction and authority of the LTA.
- 2.** Play will commence no earlier than 9.30am each day.
- 3.** Players not ready for play at the scheduled times may be disqualified.
- 4.** ITF Approved tennis balls will be used.
- 5.** All open Senior events will be the best of three tie break sets. The tie breaker system as adopted by TENNIS SCOTLAND will be used at six games all in each set. Open Junior events will be two tie break sets plus a match tie break (first to 10 points) to decide the match if required. The tie breaker system as adopted by TENNIS SCOTLAND will be used at six games all in each of the first two sets. In the 12 and Under and 10 and Under events each match will be of two short (first to four games) tie break sets with a match tie break (first to 10 points) played to decide the match if each player has won one set. The 9 and Under event will be the best of 3 tie breaks, and the 8 and Under event will be one match tie break. Handicap events will be best of three short sets throughout each event. Events will be either knockout, compass or round robin, depending on the size of the entry for each event.
- 6.** All competitors are restricted to entering a maximum of five events. Every effort will be made to find partners if required for doubles events.
- 7.** Weather permitting, the 9 and Under and 8 and Under events will be played to a conclusion on Sunday 25 July, and the 10 and Under will be played to a conclusion on Monday 26 July.
- 8.** The Tournament Committee reserves full power to alter the programme in any way they think proper and to refuse any entry without assigning any reason.
- 9.** Should insufficient entries be received for any event, such event may be deleted from the programme at the discretion of the committee.
- 10.** The trophies will remain the property of the Tournament Committee and will be returned to the Club engraved and at the Holder's own expense prior to next year's tournament.
- 11.** At the discretion of the Referee, only recognised tennis clothing must be worn.

12. Any player may be required to make him/herself available to participate in doping control procedures if selected, undertaken by a doping control officer appointed by UK Sport.
13. The referee is not bound to accept any time restrictions requested by the competitors.
14. It remains the competitor's responsibility to find out their playing time.
15. No complaints in connection with the Tournament will be entertained unless made in writing and lodged with the Tournament Secretary for decision by the Tournament Committee within 48 hours of the event giving rise to complaint.
16. All UK based players (playing in a singles event) **MUST** have an LTA Rating and Membership Number. If you do not currently have this information, please phone the LTA on 020 8487 7000 or log on to www.lta.org.uk/Membership/joinnow and they will provide one. **The LTA Rating & Membership Number, and Date of Birth of all junior participants MUST BE INCLUDED ON THE ENTRY FORM.**
17. I consent to the details provided on this entry form being used to update the membership record of the person identified and to the LTA and/or organisers of LTA tournaments, from my geographical area, using the details provided on the entry form to communicate information about this and future tournament, in my geographical area, via post/email or SMS.
18. The draw will take place in the clubhouse on Thursday 22nd July 2009 at 7.30pm. Times of play for Sunday 25th and Monday 26th July can be ascertained by phoning Doug Soutar on 07796 113643 on Saturday 24th July between 6.00pm and 10.00pm. The programme of play for the following day will be posted on the Club notice board each evening, as early as it is possible for the Tournament Referee to do so, and times for the following day can be obtained from Doug Soutar after 9.00pm the preceding day.

However, in the event of inclement weather, matches may be changed from the blaes courts at Duff Avenue to the nearby polymeric courts at Cooper Park.
